



Town of Easton Road Repaving: 2010

- Work should be substantially complete this summer on the Foundry Street Project (Route 123) from the Norton Town Line to Hannaford's Plaza with the completion of the sidewalk and final top course of paving.
- Reconstruction of the Five Corners intersection should begin this year. The 100% plans have been submitted to the state and advertising for this job should occur within a few months.
- The State will be reconstructing the intersection of Foundry Street and Turnpike Street, including new traffic signals.
- Paving has been scheduled for the week of May 3rd for Highland Street from Bay Road to Foundry Street, Kingsly Road and Knollwood Street.
- Standley Road, Parkview Circle, and Summer Street from Center to Randall Street, are scheduled for paving later during 2010 after some drainage improvements are completed in those areas.
- Drainage and sidewalk improvements will be done on Center Street.
- Areas of Depot Street, Beaver Dam Road and Dean Street are scheduled for crack sealing during spring of 2010.
- If funds are approved at the 2010 Annual Town Meeting design of the Prospect Street/Foundry Street Intersection improvements can begin.
