High Efficiency Water Heating Rebates:
Gas Networks has posted its 2010 Residential and Commercial High Efficiency Rebate forms online.
Rebates include:
Save \$1,000–\$1600 on eligible combined high-efficiency boiler and water units.
Save \$500 on an eligible indirect water heater or condensing gas water heater.
Save \$700 on an eligible high-efficiency on-demand tank-less water heater.

Massachusetts Appliance Rebates:

In March 2010, Massachusetts will announce the details of a program that will help residents replace older, inefficient appliances with new, ENERGY STAR® qualified and ultra-efficient appliances.

Eligible products will include:

- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- Clothes washers
- Dishwashers

For refrigerators and freezers, consumers must purchase from participating retailers that will recycle the replaced units and provide proof of recycling for consumers to submit. Other replaced appliances must be recycled according to state law.
Total Funding: \$6,235,000
